School-Based Health Center Services

Starting **May 1, 2025**, Highmark Blue Cross Blue Shield will cover services from School-Based Health Centers (SBHC).

What are SBHC services?

An SBHC is located in a school and is available to the students enrolled in that school. SBHCs offer a variety of primary medical, social, mental health, and health education services including, but not limited to:

- Health check-ups and well-child visits,
- Diagnosis and treatment of injuries and sickness,
- Diagnosis and ongoing care of chronic health problems,
- Family planning and reproductive health services,
- Dental services such as oral exams and fluoride treatments, and
- Some SBHCs have dental clinics which also offer cleanings, fillings, and other preventive and restorative services.
